

Reserve your **Meyer or White Spruce Trees** from Whispering Pines Tree Farm, Oconto today and pick them up when the frost starts to come out of the ground!

Meyer Spruce trees are most notable for its distinct, blue-green color and tapering conical shape. But what sets it apart is its disease resistance, including the bothersome tip weevil and Rhizophæra. This tree prefers full sunlight and is very adaptable to both dry and moist growing conditions but will not tolerate any standing water. Deer don't particularly care for this plant and will usually leave it alone in favor of tastier treats. The Meyer Spruce is recommended for vertical accents and windbreaks.

White Spruce are very hardy and easy to grow. In landscapes they are great as natural windbreaks, or in stands of mixed trees. They will grow up to 60' with a spread up to 20'. They are tough against cold weather and wind. They prefer full sun and do well with at least 6 hours of direct sunlight per day. They like soil that is slightly acidic and moist but well-draining. They grow best in loam but do well in sand and even well-drained clay. White Spruce are deer resistant.

Priced per size: The trees are "balled" which means the root ball (soil plus roots) has been dug up and wrapped in burlap/bag for transporting the tree. This method protects the roots from drying out.

3' Meyer Spruce or White Spruce balled and burlapped \$90
